Lew Yung-Chien was born in Shanghai. An Arts Graduate from the National Taiwan Normal University, he finished his studies in design and graphic arts at the École supérieure des arts modernes de Paris. He teaches tai chi, his passion, at the university as well as in various hospitals and parks in the Montreal area. He is the author of *L'esprit du tai-chi* (2009) and he also devotes himself to art forms such as calligraphy, photography, painting and pottery.

The book's foreword was written by Jacques Languirand, author and radio presenter who has been hosting Par 4 chemins on CBC's French-language radio for 40 years. He received the Governor General's Award for his plays *Les Insolites* and *Les Violons de l'automne*. In 2003, he was named Officer of the Order of Canada, and in 2004, Chevalier de l'Ordre national du Québec.
